



Class 8: Horse Sport Ireland Foal Championship Qualifier in association with the Mayo/Roscommon Breeders Group

The Championship has a prize fund of almost €24,000. The aim is to identify, evaluate and reward breeders who have bred a foal that has the potential to be competitive at the highest level in the disciplines of showjumping or eventing. There will be 6 regional qualifiers with separate categories and sections for horses and ponies for potential showjumping foals and potential eventing foals. The qualifiers will be held in August and September where 4 foals will be selected for the final at each regional qualifier. The best show jumping type foal, and the best eventing type foal from both categories. There will also be a prize at each of the qualifiers for the best traditionally-bred foal in the horse sections.

Criteria for entry

- For the horse section, foals must be registered in a studbook that is a member of the WBFSH or DAFM approved (pending DNA where this can be verified by the studbook is acceptable) and should be shown with their dams where possible.
- For the pony section, foals must be registered originally in a EU approved studbook and should be shown with their dams where possible.
- For the pony section foals are permitted to enter more than one regional qualifier but once qualified for the final cannot compete again.
- Foals in the horse section are only permitted to enter one regional qualifier but **will not be** limited to competing in the region in which the competitor resides.
- Foals must be entered in either the Showjumping Section **or** the Eventing Section. They **cannot** compete in both sections.
- The dam's passport should be available on the day for inspection. For the pony section the dam may be measured.
- All foals must be a minimum of 6 weeks old to compete at the Final.
- All foals must be named in order to compete in the Final.
- A veterinary surgeon will be available at all the qualifiers to microchip, mark and DNA the foal. This service is included in the fee for entering the class. Owners are required to have a mare declaration submitted on the IHR online database at least two weeks prior to the class. Mare Declarations Online allow you to enter the details of your mare coverings online and free of charge. By submitting a mare declaration you will ensure that a foaling kit will be generated and this can be brought to the qualifier for the veterinary surgeon. Any issues that might delay your passport can also be resolved using mare declarations online. If a change of ownership is needed for your mare that can be requested when submitting your mare declaration. - A covering certificate is required to be submitted by the stallion owner to complete the foal registration in advance of the final.

In order to be eligible for this TIH Category foals must meet the following definition as outlined by HSI and the Traditional Irish Horse Association (TIHA):

Be registered in the Main Section of the Irish Sport Horse Studbook

And

Have only the following breeds recorded in their pedigree: Irish Sport Horse, Irish Draught, Thoroughbred, Connemara Pony. Do not have any foreign ancestors recorded in their back pedigree

And

Have no unknown ancestors in the first two generations

And

All Irish Sport Horse ancestors from the second generation back with unknown/partial pedigree must have been born before 1982.

Foals are presented loose alongside mare individually for evaluation by a HSI approved inspector for conformation and movement. A team of skilled Young Breeders shall be available to assist in the presentation of mares and foals on the day.
